GLOW meeting with Ward 1 Councilors

GLOW is meeting with Ward 1 Councilors on 7th November to review the following.

PDP 2023 report. When is it to be presented, what is the Budget and what time for implementation? **Check where land Acquisition is in the WMP**, especially with the proposed Incentive Uplift DAs that impact on these sites.

Transport Land Wickham Park Access in Wickham Park. GLOW negotiated with NSW Government for BUDGET of \$1m. Now time if Ward 1 councilors could investigate Council progress with acquisition of the Bullock Island land.

Highrise Railway St Union Street Bishopsgate Street. Wickham development is non- complying. GLOW hopes that Ward 1 councilors will ask for regular briefings and stay informed on Compliance. Bowline -traffic permits and oversized truck movement on all inner Wickham streets until 2026. Garbage across the area needs review. Wheelie bins and Skip bins always have the lids torn off. Rubbish is not contained.

41-47 Throsby Street -stay informed on Compliance and protecting the Wickham Village Hub. **Railway Lane adjacent to Lass O Gowrie** is the Youth Live Music area. Railway Lane is attracting anti social behaviour. Dumping, stolen wrecked cars. This is unsafe for the youth of a night. This has been raised with Councilors and Youth Council and reported to Waste management officers.

Return & Earn update on site is monitored and photographed daily for 12months by GLOW. This site has resulted in dumping and garbage spread across the area and Wickham Park. EPA, CEO, Transport NSW and ministers notified. CEO Council has met with NSWTCN and EPA. What is the outcome to move the R&E (before the Passmore Grandstand is completed). This site has caused garbage congestion and mess at the Passmore Oval entrance. A review has been requested to make the area safe from garbage and littering from the R& E site, once the Passmore oval grandstand is back to full community function. **Foot paths black asphalt around Lindstrom**. Why does the heat bank continue?

Requested level path at the Post Office on Throsby Street & Hannell Street bus stop garbage bin. **Webforms** restricting feedback and requests.
