Looking back on 2021

- "GLOW AGM" December elected new committee/officially registered with Fair Trading NSW.

28/07/20 - Councillors (except Cr Church) endorsed Planning Proposal (PP), preparation of a draft Planning Agreement (PA) & their public exhibition. The PP results in:

- . Increased Floor-Space-Ratio from 1.5:1 to 3:1 on both 41 and 47 Throsby St;
- . Increased Height-of-Building for part of 41 Throsby St and all of 47 Throsby St from 10m to 28m; &
- . Increased Height-of-Building for the remainder part of 41 Throsby St from 10m to 22m.

In exchange, the PA will construct & dedicate a 6.5 m wide public lane to connect with Furlong Lane.

5/08/20 - City of Newcastle (CN) applied for Gateway Determination from NSW DPIE.

1/01/21 - NSW DPIE recommended PP to proceed with a few conditions, in particular consultation with Subsidence Advisory NSW.

4/10/21 - Public exhibition of PP and draft PA commenced and closed 29/11/21.

GLOW is aware of numerous submissions opposing this development, the PP to amend Newcastle LEP 2012 compromising the revitalisation of WMP Village Hub and are waiting on CN for their feedback. GLOW is organising a petition in readiness to submit to Councillors when this matter is next on the agenda.
